- Presentation materials are nearly completed to go to potential financial underwriters. A **team** of people has been working on this for several weeks.
- Meetings with a certified public accountant and our volunteer bookkeeping team are developing. He will advise on bringing the Museum's accounting into Quick Books and do the annual tax preparation.
- The new Digital Team of five volunteers met to discuss the NWSM's development of the **Web Site**, the **Face Book Page** and the **NewsLetter**. Everyone was brought up to date on where we are, discussed where we want to get to in the near future, and

methods of accomplishing all of it. Board member Amber Johnson is overseeing these projects, and all submissions will go through her oversight process. The **SLACK** instant communications program was recommended for all teams to try for quick effective communications and planning strategies.

The board of directors and the volunteers would like to re-locate the NWSM Vision Center from the current Boise location to the Gateway Mall in Nampa. There is a store front immediately next door to the location desired for the Museum to expand into. This store front is not quite double the square footage, which would allow some additional displays and secure storage. It would give the Vision Center much more exposure to the public immediately! There are good businesses around there with foot and vehicle traffic coming and going. It would also be so very much closer and accessible for the Board and volunteers! Please pray with us about the increased costs.

We have the materials and volunteers in place to cast the three juvenile sculpted dinosaurs with the molds that we obtained from Texas. A donor provided for 200 lbs of plaster, a 2 ft stack of burlap sacking was donated by Treasure Valley Roasters, volunteers are in place to start cutting the burlap into strips, and volunteers have said they will help cast the replicas!!! Stan will instruct the team in the process. He also wants to put castors under the first one, anticipating pulling it outside each day to attract visitors at the Gateway Mall. Even in front of the "relocated Vision Center" if we rent it. All these people have created a **TEAM** to accomplish the project! May God's blessings see it through to completion.
